Title: The Wind Abides No Secrets

A maternal love is challenged when a tragic accident destroys a young boy's life. Unable to convince his family or the community of his innocence, he takes his own life out of desperation only to awaken unexplained forces of the supernatural world. Now trapped in limbo, dark forces threaten to claim his soul unless an unlikely guardian from behind the veil can clear his name before the blood moon rises to seal his fate.

Voice of an older female narrator opens the story with how she has watched the boy grow to become a young man and how she loves the boy. The boy is swimming in the lake with his best friend when his friend tragically drowns. Conflicting scenes show how both boys possess both good and bad traits that leave the reader uncertain how to interpret the event. The boy is blamed for the death of his friend. Unable to convince anyone of his innocence, he becomes distraught and hangs himself from the tree overlooking the lake. The maternal voice of the narrator describes how she is heartbroken. She now watches the soul of the boy wandering in limbo, unable to find peace until he is vindicated.

Time passes and a new family moves into the house overlooking the lake. The help of an empath must be enlisted to reveal the truth and clear his name before the rising of the blood moon closes the path to salvation forever. Realizing the boy is not able to see past his own dimension, the maternal voice must risk her own life by defying natural law to clear the boy and banish the dark forces that threaten to take over.

Story Goal:

Clear the boy's name so his soul can transcend into heaven and finally be at peace. Good must rise up to triumph over evil.

Consequence(s):

Dark forces will claim not only the boy's soul but also the community.

The maternal figure will die of a broken heart taking all living things with her as she is the source of life around her.

The maternal figure cannot return home if she fails, and everything in the natural environment will die with her.

Requirements:

The narrator must find an empath. The empath must uncover the truth behind the tragedy. The empath must communicate the truth to others to clear the boy's name.

The boy's name must be cleared before the rising of the blood moon which will close the path to salvation forever.

Forewarnings:

The boy's spirit is becoming dim... becoming angry... turning to the dark forces...

A dark villain is enticing the boy to come with him.

The dark villain is taunting the female narrator. The dark villain reminds the female narrator he will claim her soul too if she cannot complete her mission to save the boy before the rising of the blood moon. Once the blood moon rises, the woman's path home will disappear and darkness will reign.

Elements in the natural environment start turning brown, leaves start falling off trees, as a sign that darkness is coming. The tree by the lake develops a black spot on the trunk that slowly grows, threatening to consume the tree.

Costs:

The woman narrator cannot go home, thus dying, if she fails. The natural environment will also die with the woman and dark forces will reign over the once beautiful land.

The black spot on the tree is a portal of evil that will open if the woman narrator fails.

Empath must risk her marriage to listen to the message, get involved, and save the boy.

Dividends:

The empaths husband finally accepts her 'gift' and her power strengthens with his commitment.

Prerequisites:

The empath must hear the message. The empath must take action. Others must believe the empath and a collective forgiveness of the boy must transpire.

Actions must be taken before the rise of the blood moon when the dark villain will come to take the boy and the female narrator.

Preconditions:

The female narrator must get approval from higher power to break the rules in order to save the boy.

Empath must convince her husband her gift is not a curse...can save humanity from evil.

Ending:

The events of the tragedy are revealed in a shocking plot twist solving the question of whether the boy is really good or evil. Identity of the woman narrator is revealed and is a surprise to reader. Narrator and empath save the boy and ward off evil forces.
